The Day of Workshops features a full day of topic driven meetings, speakers, and activities, as well as a large raffle, and lots and lots of food potluck style!

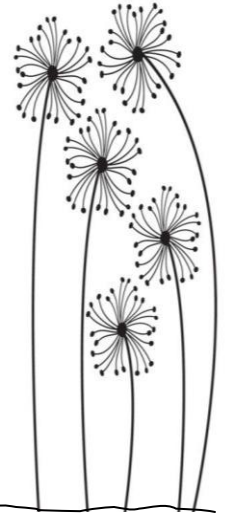
