HEADLINE: AI-Anon is for men

Yes, of course, Al-anon is also for men. If you are male and feel hesitant about attending meetings, you should know there are two weekly meetings for men in District 7 (Pinellas County).

One is on Tuesday nights, from 8 to 9, at the Northwest Presbyterian Church, 6330 54th Avenue, St.

Petersburg. This group -- known as the S.T.A.G. group - has been meeting since 2010. Btw, it is said

that STAG stands for Steps and Traditions for Al-Anon Gentlemen

Another meeting for men is on Wednesday nights, from 7 to 8, at our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church, 750 San Salvador Drive in Dunedin. This is Dunedin Men's AFG

But what are the reasons a man may want to attend a men's meeting? Perhaps he just doesn't want to share some things with women present. And if his wife also attends maybe he doesn't want to share some personal things. Or, it could be none of the above. I attend several different meetings a week, including Tuesday's S. T. A. G. meeting, and early on I realized that every meeting has a different vibe and they are all helpful. Meetings for men can give a man a fresh outlook on how to work the program and he may feel more member support. Importantly, when he is looking for a sponsor, he will meet more men. In fact, Al-Anon, Alcoholics-Anonymous, and Narcotics Anonymous all recommend same sex sponsorship. and there is this insight from a male member in the Al-Anon book ... In All Our Affairs:

" I know several men in the fellowship who grew up with alcoholism, as I did. They have helped me understand and accept the isolation that I lived with and even cultivated. Feeling closer to these people, I have come to feel closer to myself. Hearing the struggles these men have had establishing intimacy in their lives and making room for their feelings, I have been able to be gentler and more understanding of myself."

WHAT IS HAPPENING IN THE FORUM?

Talk about Surrender

When I first came to Al-Anon, all the God-talk put me off. I heard Al-Anon is a spiritual program, not a religious one, and yet I heard everyone talking about God. For a while I mouthed the words, which did me no good whatsoever. Although I kept coming back to meetings, there was a wall between me and recovery. That wall was God.

I didn't want anything to do with the vindictive, punishing God of my youth. That image came to me from organized religion–run by people who went to church on Sunday morning and seemed to forget what they'd learned by Sunday afternoon.

Gradually, I came to understand that I needed a Higher Power to get to Step Two. Al-Anon people had what I wanted, so I decided the meetings would be my Higher Power. That idea worked for me.

My concept of a Higher Power grew to encompass my sponsor, the Steps, readings, and members of Al-Anon. I still didn't call my Higher Power "God." When that word came up, I substituted "Higher Power" or "Creator." By Shar H., Ohio

One day I finally heard the magic words, "The God of my understanding." Finally I understood that my Higher Power didn't have to be the God of my youth. This idea really made me think. After a long time, I decided the Higher Power of my understanding is a loving entity who cries when we cry, laughs when we laugh, and mourns at the pain and suffering we go through here on earth. I used to question God about famine, abuse, and war. Now I believe that most of the problems on this planet stem from the free will that God gave to us as individuals.

Gradually, I began to call my Higher Power, "God." It just seemed simpler and it saved me a lot of effort, rather than constantly searching for another word to use as a substitute. My sponsor pointed out that this was what I was doing, and we laughed together-talk about surrender.

Today, God and I talk a lot. We've become friends and I've come to trust in God's will, not mine. Sometimes I even remember to Let Go and Let God, and that feels very good.

WHAT IS HAPPENING AT WSO?

Who Keeps the Group Connected to the WSO?

The Current Mailing Address (CMA) for the group is a crucial link between the group and World Service Office (WSO) information. The CMA ensures that the group promptly receives all time-sensitive postal and electronic communications from the WSO and local service arms and shares the content with the group members. The CMA may be but does not have to be the Group Representative or another group officer.

Communications the CMA receives from the WSO include:

- In The Loop, the WSO email newsletter;
- the <u>Quarterly Appeal letters</u>, which provide members the opportunity to support Al-Anon Family Groups worldwide by contributing directly to the WSO; and
- an Annual Update Sheet listing the current group information on file with the WSO for verification, so that anyone seeking Al-Anon's help can find your meeting.

Groups can submit an Al-Anon <u>Group Records</u> Change Form online to update the CMA information and avoid interruption of service.
