



Sharings from our DIS Chairs

"When I got busy, I got better." My Higher Power "nudged" me into Al-Anon service. I felt isolated and depleted without a sense of purpose or joy. At the time, I was recovering physically, mentally, spiritually and emotionally from a health challenge and the effects of the Covid pandemic. I eagerly looked forward to Al-Anon face to face meetings and events.

I felt hopeful as I became involved with service as chair for Raffle/Registration at our monthly meetings. I remembered how much fun other members had had in this position. This might be something I could do, a spiritual awakening!

As the end of my term approached, I began thinking about my next "growth opportunity" in District. I read the job description for CPC, Cooperating with the Professional Community. Perhaps I might have something to share, though it wasn't clear to me what that was. I stood and was voted CPC chair.

Where to begin? I spoke to the standing CPC member; they suggested focusing on one professional group. My higher power provided me with my first opportunity for service with the Pinellas County Juvenile Welfare Board. A fellow member and I attended a JWB community resource fair for young adults and their families. We carried the message of help and hope to families and other professional organizations in attendance. We even enjoyed a lunch buffet! After that event, I didn't know exactly how the next year would unfold.

While driving behind a public bus I noticed an ad for AA on the back panel. Why not Al-Anon ads on Pinellas County buses? At a Zoom meeting for Area CPC chairs I learned there were several Al-Anon and Alateen ads on the WSO website. I chose two images for production, one for Al-Anon, one for Alateen, and presented these at District. I was humbled when the Group Representatives (GR's) voted to support the project. Thanks, HP!

Service work has been a series of HP "nudges." Now in my third year of service, I drove by a digital street sign for a Youth Mental Health Festival at Largo Park. I applied to the City of Largo and will attend with our District Alateen Process person (DAPP), an AMIAS (Al-Anon member in Alateen Service) to share CAL literature (Conference Approved Literature) and other materials, M&M fun packs included!

As my term as CPC draws to an end, I am grateful for the growth opportunities I have had in our District and community. I have acquired a sense of belonging, trust and humility. Al-Anon District 7 elections will be held in September. I've asked HP to guide me to my next service position. I'm just waiting for that gentle "nudge!"



Another amazing share from our Archivist, Shelly How Eleven and Eleven, AFG got it's name:

Grace and her husband, George, moved to Florida from Maryland in the late sixties because of George's health. They built a home on Clearwater Beach. Grace was startled to find out that the Clearwater Alanon meetings were all at the Serenity Club on Turner St.. Not that there were that many in the sixties. She started several in the Clearwater area. She said all you needed was a place to meet and to contact Alanon headquarters in New York (now Virginia Beach) to get registered. She helped start the district's literature distribution center, as well. Grace started Alateen in our district, too. She laughed about how, at convention, the teens would whisper to each other, "Is she asleep, yet?" - hoping that she had fallen asleep so that they could sneak out.

In 1989, the last meeting Grace started, along with Spanky (moved back to Texas) was "Eleven and Eleven." We met at the First Lutheran Church on Lake and Nursery. By then George (who was an AA member) was on oxygen, and she wanted to be close by. We had babysitting at that meeting. The reason she gave for naming it Eleven and Eleven was that eleven was her favorite step, and that it started at 11 o'clock in the morning.

Worry and Hope

My mother loved snowmen. She collected them over the years. She crocheted me an entire snowman family which I prize dearly. Every time I put it out, it reminds me of her. When I was a kid, we lived in Ohio. We had a lot of snow. We loved to make snowmen. We would make a snowball and roll it down the hill until it got big enough to be the body. It was packed and glistening white. We were old school, not coal but rocks for eyes and a carrot for a mouth. I would insist on putting a scarf on my new friend so he wouldn't get cold. Sometimes if we weren't careful, we would roll up more than just snow in our snow ball, there were a lot of critters around, cows, horses, hound dogs. Sometimes something stinky and unpleasant would end up in our snowball. But usually if we stuck to the path, we would stay out of the stinky stuff.

This activity makes me think about worry. When I start to worry, I have a snowball in my hand. I get to decide what makes it bigger. When I worry some more, it does get bigger, but not in a good way. As I keep worrying and worrying, creating new and more terrible scenarios, that snowball gets really big and pretty stinky. I may end up with a very unhappy snowman, with sticks and stinky stuff sticking out all over.

What if I try hope instead? Thinking good thoughts and imagining my loved one in wonderful situations, with friends and family and lots of love. I can make my snowball just as big but much more beautiful and my snowman will thank me for it.


